

- The Willoughby Leisure Centre (WLC) is a non-smoking venue.
- Please observe pool rule at all times,
- We advise/request patrons to shower before entering the water.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry.
- Any Patrons under the influence of alcohol/drugs will not be permitted into the Centre (WLC).
- Anyone attempting to gain entry without paying or without authorisation will be prosecuted.
- Patrons are not permitted to bring glass objects or alcohol into the Centre (WLC).
- Patron's bags may be searched.
- A high standard of behaviour is expected from Members at all times. Willoughby Leisure Centre (WLC) Management reserves the right to terminate and prohibit further entry to any person found to be in breach of the Centre's (WLC) rules and regulations
- Abusive, disruptive or offensive behaviour and language are not permitted.
- Children under the age of 10 years must be closely supervised by an adult – (16 years and over).
- Only recognised swimwear, made from lycra and nylon is to be worn in the water.
- Only recognised waterproof nappies are to be worn in the water for infants
- Articles of clothing such as cut-off jeans, t-shirts, bike-pants, leotards, casual wear and sporting wear are strictly prohibited in the pool.
- No pets or animals permitted in the Centre (WLC),with the exception of Guide Dogs.
- Only Centre (WLC) staff are permitted to conduct learn to swim and private swimming lessons within the Centre (WLC) as part of the Swim School Programs.
- Patrons must comply with all reasonable requests and directives made by Centre (WLC) staff. Failure to comply may result in expulsion from the Centre (WLC).
- Bags and large items cannot be taken into the gym,spa,sauna and spinroom areas. Lockers are provided for use.
- Willoughby Leisure Centre (WLC) accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen personal property or belongings.
- Cameras and mobile phone cameras are not permitted in change rooms or the Play Club
- Risk and Responsibility: There is always a risk of injury when using the Centre's (WLC) equipment and facilities. The Centre (WLC) does not accept any responsibility for any such injury and Patrons must accept that risk. Patrons must disclose to the Centre (WLC) any circumstances which may affect safety or increase risk or injury. To minimise that risk Patrons must comply with all safety directions issued by the Centre (WLC) staff and management.

- Swim School Parents and children should remain on deck until a Swim Teacher is on duty at which time the child may enter the pool for their lesson.
- No Smoking * No Running *No Bombing
- Diving is not permitted unless under the supervision of a Coach or Instructor and only in the deepend of the pool.
- Patrons are strictly prohibited from taking glass objects into the Pool area.
- Parents are not permitted to take photos of children in the pool or pooldeck area.
