

## **Willoughby City Library Internet Usage Guidelines**

Willoughby City Library Service provides free access to the internet through its public computers and Wi-Fi.

Parents/guardians of children under the age of 18 are solely responsible for their child's access to and use of the Library's internet facilities, including access to sites, their subject matter and content.

### **Unacceptable Usage**

If a client is found to be using the Library computers or network to access pornographic, offensive or objectionable material, or for any unlawful or inappropriate purpose, the Library has the right to direct the client to leave the Library and not to re-enter the Library for a specified period. Unlawful conduct will be reported to the relevant authorities.

Clients are not permitted to use the internet service for commercial activity or gambling.

Clients must not modify or gain access to restricted files or data belonging to others.

Clients must not damage equipment or alter the set-up of computers used to access the internet.

Clients must not use their personal software on the Library's computers.

Clients must be sensitive to the values and beliefs of others when displaying potentially offensive or objectionable information or images on computer screens located in public areas.
