

Archipaws Pet Portrait Competition

Entry Dates

Competition opens from Monday 8 July 2019

Submissions due by 5pm on Friday 9 August 2019

Now in its second year, artists of all 2D media are encouraged to enter the Archipaws Pet Portrait competition. Entries are accepted from painters, illustrators and photographers. Portraits are encouraged to have direct eye contact with the viewer.

The top 20 entries will have their artwork transformed into flags in the Chatswood CBD to promote the Pet Festival 2019. Your artwork will also be featured in a gallery on Council's Facebook with a people's choice award via most likes.

Finalists will be presented with their prize pack at the Pet Festival, Saturday 21 September, 9am – 3pm at OH Reid Oval, Chatswood West.

Terms and Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

- The Archipaws Pet Portrait Competition is open to artists of all ages who are a resident of Australia.
- One entry per pet. Multiple entries of the same pet will be disqualified.
- The entrant must own copyright in the image submitted.
- The entry must depict a companion animal.

2. ENTRY

- The entry must be a physical submission for painting, drawing or illustrations.
- High resolution digital photo entries can be submitted online.
- The entry must be in portrait format at a 2:1 ratio.
- The entry must not be larger than 40cm in height.
- The entrant must complete an online submission form and include the same contact details with the artwork.
- You agree to the Terms and Conditions of Entry by filling in the entry form.

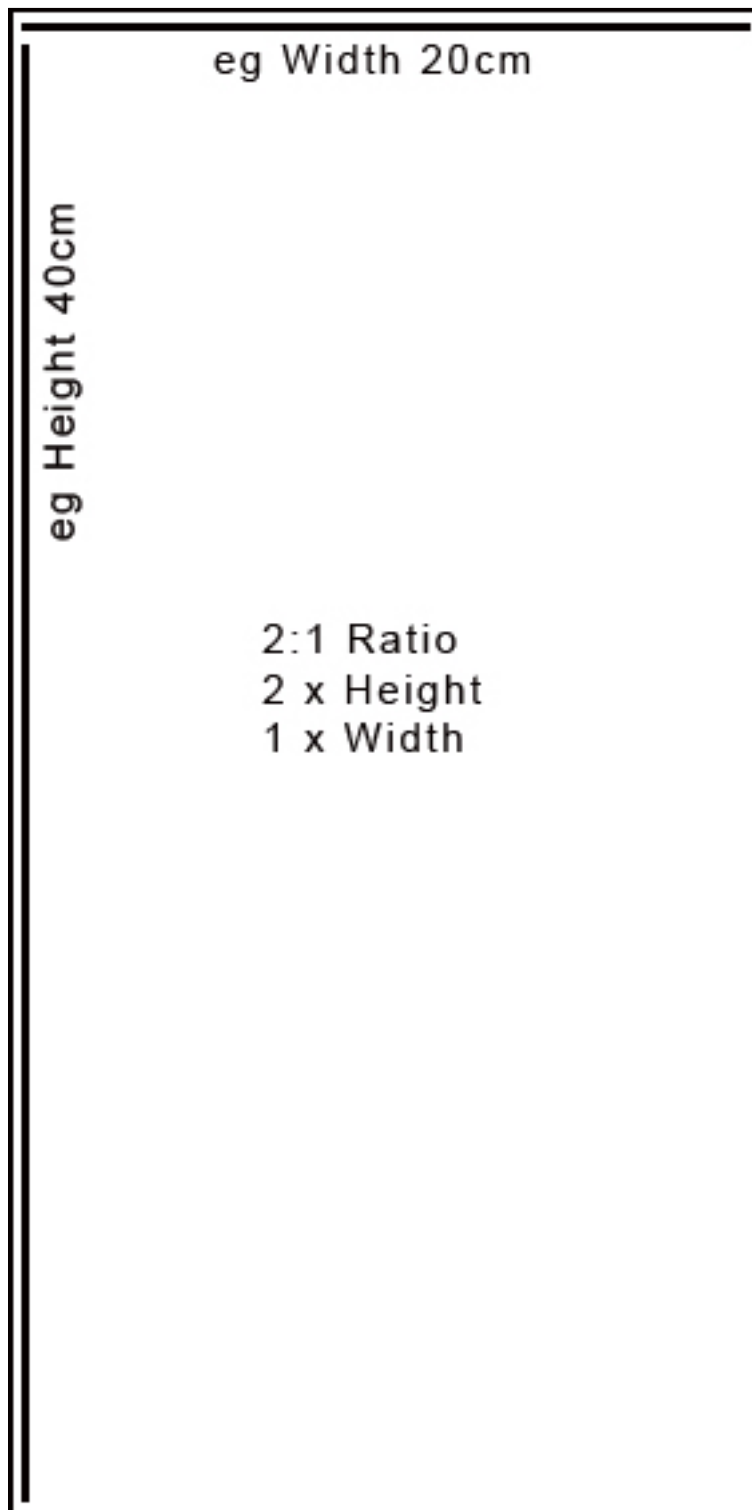

3. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The aspect ratio of the submission must be 2:1 Portrait. The height must be twice the width. If the submission is outside this, WCC will crop the image.



4. JUDGING

Submissions will be scored by a judging panel chosen by Willoughby City Council. Finalists will be notified once chosen and portraits made into flags for the Chatswood CBD.

5. RETURN OF MATERIALS

Artworks will be available for collection from Willoughby City Council. Willoughby City Council accepts no liability for loss or damage to artwork.

6. GRANT OF RIGHTS

By entering the Archipaws Pet Portrait Competition, you acknowledge and agree that if your artwork is selected for display, that Willoughby City Council has the right to screen and reproduce the design in any way or form during the festival, and in future years.

By submitting your entry, you grant the Willoughby City Council the right to publicise, broadcast and communicate to the public your name, character, likeness or voice for any promotion or matter related to the Competition with no compensation to you for such use.

7. PRIZES

Prize packs and their flag will be awarded to finalists at the Pet Festival on Saturday 21 September.
